Certification of the Board of Supervisors of Elections

TO THE HONORABLE TOWN COUNCIL OF CENTREVILLE, MARYLAND

We hereby certify that on October 7, 2019, an election was held for the purpose of electing one (1) Town Council member for a three (3) year term and to vote on a charter amendment. The election was held at the Queen Anne’s County Office Building, 110 Vincit Street, Centreville, Maryland.

There were two (2) candidates: Joshua E. Shonts and George G. Sigler.

There was also Question A: Charter Amendment to Increase the Number of Town Council Members from three (3) to five (5) with two options:

- FOR the Proposed Charter Amendment
- AGAINST the Proposed Charter Amendment

The polls were open from 7:00 a.m. to 7:00 p.m. (EST), with Robert G. Norris, Sr. and John C. Beskid conducting the election.

Votes were cast by handwritten ballots. For the candidates there were 662 votes recorded. 642 votes were cast in person and 20 absentee ballots were submitted. Of the total ballots cast, there were 5 provisional ballot(s), and 8 spoiled ballot(s).

Votes were cast by handwritten ballots. For Question A there were 665 votes recorded. 645 votes were cast in person and 20 absentee ballots were submitted. Of the total ballots cast, there were 5 provisional ballot(s), and 5 spoiled ballot(s).

Immediately after the polls closed, the Board tallied the number of votes cast, as follows:


